Be sure to know the difference between a SECURE CAMPUS and a LOCKDOWN emergency response.


A **SECURE CAMPUS** is called for when there is a potential threat of violence in the surrounding area or police activity nearby. If you hear a secure campus called on the speakers, calmly go indoors and lock all classrooms and office doors.

Remain indoors until otherwise directed and continue your classwork. You may unlock when an all clear is announced over the speakers.



A **LOCKDOWN/BARRICADE** emergency response is put in motion when there is a violent intruder on campus. If you hear LOCKDOWN/BARRICADE on the speakers, and only if the intruder is not near you, get safely off campus and find a position of cover and stay there. Report your location. If you do not know where the intruder is or cannot get off campus safely, clear all hallways and get all students and staff inside. Once all doors and windows are closed and locked, barricade doors and windows. All staff and students should remain still and quiet.

Turn off/silence cell phones. If unable to find cover inside a secure room, quickly seek out a hiding place on campus. Do not leave your locked room or hiding location unless your safety is in danger.

Admin or law enforcement will unlock your door from the outside.






