Dear Mustang Families,

Have you gotten your **Parent Participation Card** yet? If not, you can obtain one at any parent meeting or stop by the front office to pick one up.

What is the Parent Engagement Incentive Program? This program is designed to increase parent participation in school events and help families become more familiar with school activities.

How does it work?

- Parents/guardians can pick up a **Participation Card** in the front office.
- Each time you attend a designated school event—such as academic counseling sessions, athletic events, or parent evening workshops—you will collect a stamp.
- Once your card is filled, you can submit it to the main office for entry into a **student scholarship raffle**.
- Families with multiple students at KCHS may pick up one card per student.
- If a card is lost, a new one can be issued, but stamps will need to be collected again.
- Cards are valid only for this school year; new cards will be provided next year.

We are excited to strengthen the connection between our school and the families we serve.
